As I meditate upon the great accomplishments of our graduates of 2022, I think about how important it is to stand with strength and courage to go the distance. Access to the 7:00pm Wednesday Night Bible Study is now accessible via the "new and improved" Queen's Chapel UMC website.




1. Log on to the website at www.qcumc.org






