"Transferable Faith"

1) What is Faith?

A) Faith is seeing from God's point of view **Hebrews 11:1 (NLT)**

2) What is Transferable Faith?

A) Transferable Faith is a personal faith

- Birth from the Word of God—Romans 10:17 (NKJV)
- Demonstrated through one's action —James 2:18
- Illustrated through one's character—Galatians 2:20

3) What is Genuine Faith

A) Genuine faith is sincere faith—free from deceit and falseness.

B) People with genuine sincere faith will live their lives in 3 major ways (this is what Paul saw in Timothy)

- They live pure and blameless lives—Philippians 1:10 (NLT)
- Everything they do reflects what they teach—Titus 2:7 (NLT)
- Their acts of love are more than lip service—1 John 3:18 (NLT)

4) Where did Timothy receive his genuine faith? 2 Timothy 1:5b

"for you share the faith that first filled your grandmother Lois and your mother, Eunice."

A) There are three characteristics of a mother who transfers her faith to her children

- She knows God is able. Jude 1:24 (NIV)

- She knows God will do what He promises—2 Peter 1:4 (NIV)
- She knows about the “But if not.” Faith—Daniel 3:16-18 (NIV)
