

Queen's Chapel United Methodist Church High School Scholarship

Applicant eligibility:

- A graduating senior in the class of 2024 with a 3.0 GPA or higher and is a member of Queen's Chapel United Methodist Church
- A graduating senior in the class of 2024 with a 3.0 GPA or higher and is a grandchild of a member of Queen's Chapel United Methodist Church
- An active participant in school activities
- An active volunteer in the community
- Plans to pursue post-secondary education in an accredited two-year or four-year institution

Note: The award is contingent upon enrollment in an accredited two-year or four-year institution.

Instructions for Applicants

- 1. Print or type the answers to all questions on the attached personal data sheet.
- 2. Give a request for an official transcript, with your name as the applicant, to your school guidance counselor or appropriate administrator.
- 3. Provide a biographical sketch to include information to be shared with the congregation. Include your future goals, the college you plan to attend, and the major you will be pursuing.
- 4. Have three letters of recommendation completed on appropriate letterhead to include:
 (a) community representative, (b) guidance counselor or teacher or coach or advisor, and
 (a) shursh personnal or a ministry shair
 - (c) church personnel or a ministry chair.

The completed application, with required documentation, is due in the Queen's Chapel church office by Friday, May 31, 2024.
